This corner cabinet is structured so as to be placed near an angle and therefore has a triangular shape. It was built in the 19th century in France in the Louis XIV style. In wood, the front is lacquered in black and decorated with polychrome lacquer paintings of oriental inspiration. It consists of two doors that conceal a red lacquered interior and divided into two compartments by a shelf.

The lateral pillars, the legs and the lower band, which follow a wavy and arched pattern, are embellished with applications in gilded bronze finely chiselled depicting male heads, floral and Dealer

The top is in marble.
