Normal wear, see photos. \* The Netsuke: The Netsuke is a traditional Japanese clothing object used to hold sagemono (literally "hanging objects"). Indeed, the kimono not having a pocket, the various everyday objects are transported in kinds of small boxes called sagemono. These objects are suspended from their owner's obi by a cord.
