Philipp Peter Roos, called Rosa from Tivoli Sankt Goar / Frankfurt am Main, 30 August 1657 - Rome, 17 January 1706.

German painter and engraver of the Baroque period.

It belonged to a well-known family of German painters and engravers: his father was Johann Heinrich Roos, the most important German animal painter of the seventeenth century. He arrived in Italy in 1677 with a scholarship from the Langravio di Assia.
