The colors are extremely bright, the whole is in perfect condition. He did his apprenticeship in carpentry, at the same time, he studied by correspondence at the universal school, received his competitive examination, he worked in an architectural firm

In 1948 he exhibited at the Magadoux gallery in Limoges, then in Royan and in many other galleries. From 1958 he painted views of Paris and particularly those of Montmartre which made his success. He has access to the very famous Cercle Volney and to Parisian galleries such as the Roussard gallery. His paintings will be exhibited next to those of Degas, Derain, Domergue, Buffet, Braque, Picasso, Foujita, Utrillo, Laurencin, etc until 1969, year from which he will stop painting, following complications caused by a traffic accident suffered a few years before (1963). His success will allow him to live comfortably until his death on March 13, 1999 at Martoulet in Saint-Germain-Les-Belles. Shipping costs consult us.
