These large and strong carpets have always very nice colours and geometric patterns, which could be used with contemporary furniture as well as high-end furniture.

Made by nomades tribes whose looms were narrow foreasy transport, they are always made in 2 parts then knotted between them when they are used as carpets. They can also be used to insulate
