Description

Charming painting by the leader of the Provençal School Emile Loubon. The work represents a soldier certainly carrying his ration on his horse. The work is signed lower right and measures frame included 34 cm by 28 cm and 22 cm by 16.5 cm without the frame. Note that the frame needs a little restoration that I can take care of.
