Large enamelled vase with a crackled beige background, covered over almost the entire surface with armed warrior characters fighting on foot with banners and shields, dignitaries and samurai on horseback enamelled in green dominant polychromy. The neck of the vase is decorated in relief modeled with fantastic animals stylized. The bottom of the vase is signed hollow at the tip in a brown cartouche. Is from the imperial period of the Qing dynasty which reigned from 1636 to 1912. Despite production in several sizes of this type of vase, we can note that they all have different and unique decorations with multiple characters in polychrome enamelling detailed, in animated scenes, often battles, of high graphic quality.
