On the other hand, they move away from it by trying to popularize ceramic art through serial production more accessible for people, while the School of Nancy Art Nouveau creations are often luxurious, unique and therefore elitist.

By this way of mind, the MOUGIN Brothers had a central and important position on the XXth century arts and crafts history, and may be one of the clearest examples of this pivotal period between Art Deco and the later artistic trends.
