Otto MARAINI (Cuneo 1904-Savonna 1970). Italian architect, painter, sculptor and ceramist. Settled in Turin with his family, he attended the Albertina Academy. A pupil of Gigi Chessa and Felice Casorati, he graduated in architecture in 1931. As a ceramist, he worked for the most prestigious pre-war Italian brands: Lenci, Essevi,

Ars Pulchra and Igni.

After the war, abandoning ceramics, he devoted himself full time to painting, exhibiting in Italy, Switzerland and Mexico.

Retrospective at the artistic circles of Turin in 1960.
