Rare with its unusual decor of maritime landscapes in reserves, very different from the Mediterranean landscapes with metallic enamels to which the Workshop had accustomed us. On either side, the reserves surrounded by gold meet by a band decorated with seaweed and gold scallops. You will appreciate the original character of this piece, the beauty of the colors, the delicacy of its decoration painted as if it were a painting, its white cover in very slight bluish gradient going towards the collar. Double "BACS Cannes-Eden Golfe-Juan AM" mark in handwritten gold under the base + the letters BACS incised near the heel. Height: 13 cm
