He apprenticed in carpentry, at the same time, he studied by correspondence at the universal school, received his competitive examination, he worked in an architectural firm in Limoges. For his leisure, he attended the School of Decorative Arts in Limoges, then from 1934 he devoted himself to painting. In 1948 he exhibited at the Magadoux gallery in Limoges, then in Royan and in many other galleries. From 1958, he painted
