Description

Baritone sudrophone by François SUDRE made in Paris circa 1892.

Conical brass body, three Périnet valves and on the bell a device unique to this instrument: a disengageable system fitted with a silk membrane to obtain a mirliton sound effect.

Signed on a nickel silver shield on the bell.

Total height: 866 mm

Diameter of the bell: 160 mm

This instrument is part of a family ranging from soprano to double bass, invented by François SUDRE (1844 - 1912) and patented in 1892 (N $^{\circ}$ 219518). The sound is close to that of the saxhorn.
