Description

18th Century, Italian Louis XV Violet Wood Center Table

This elegant and refined center table - cabinet was made in Turin around the middle of the eighteenth century. Characteristic of the high Piedmontese cabinet making, for this piece of furniture, a veneer was chosen with the precious violet wood, applied on the piece of furniture with a sophisticated game of mirrors and patterns of the wood grain. The furniture has a shaped and wavy top, and the wooden essence creates a chromatic game called "a occhio di pernice" (partridge eye). On the front it consists of two drawers and a compartment protected by two doors. The opening system of the doors is sliding, very rare and difficult to achieve. The mouthpieces of the locks are in chiselled bronze
