Tenenkou Culture, Mali.12th to 16th century. A thermo-luminescence test confirms the antiquity of the work.Full terracotta with some restorations.Zoomorphic statue from the Inner Niger Delta, north of Djenne, named Tenenkou after the place of discovery. Only a few terracotta objects from this region are known. This mysterious quadruped with a cylindrical body, probably a horse, has thick legs, an elongated muzzle with a raised nose and half-open mouth, and a small head with erect ears and a necklace.Dimensions:Height: 37.5 cm.Length: 47 cm.Depth: 20 cm.
