


## "russian School Late XIXth (levitan?):" Birch Wood ""

Russian school circa 1900 "Birch wood", oil on panel 58 X 31 cm mounted in a large damaged golden frame 81 X 54 cm. Signature or monogram lower left made illegible by a paint chip. That same afternoon, a collector friend who had never been to this one visited me and expressed his incomprehension of the fact that I was selling the Breton painting that I was therefore repacking. So back to square one where my research led me to the late works of Isaac Lévitan (1860-1900).
