Beautiful 18th century Lorraine cabinet, in blond oak. In the center of the upper rail, a rare sculpted motif of a fleur-de-lis, a royal symbol, in a crowned medallion also surmounted by a second fleur-de-lis. In the center of the false dormant, in a medallion, the monogram AB in interlaced letter. Very beautiful waxed patina. Two doors with 3 panels and 3 drawers in the lower part. Original ironwork, lock and key. The key to the small central drawer does not work, it is used to draw it. Interior fittings on request in wardrobe or shelving. Beautiful molding, carved with branches with bunches of grapes. Small flowers carved at the top of the doors at the junction of the facing volutes. Period 18th century, Louis XV style with volutes at the end of the feet and in the doors. Good condition. Maximum dimensions at
