Gaston ANGLADE (1856-1919) - Landscape of "La Creuse" - French Province - Oil on canvas signed lower left - Old golden frame - Canvas size: 46 X 55 cm - Frame size: 61 X 70 cm -Anglade Gaston ou Leon (1854-1919) - French 19th century painter - Born in Bordeaux on September 29, 1854 - Died in 1919 - Landscape painter, watercolorist - Pupil of Joseph Baudet (1824-1870) and Léon Germain Pelouze (1838-1991) - He took part in the exhibitions of the Société des Artistes Français, of which he was a member - The stylistic similarity between the misty heather landscapes of Gaston Anglade and those of Didier Pouget is such that it provoked a legal dispute between the two artists - However, Anglade puts more fantasy in his paintings, punctuated by light effects - Bibliography: Gérald
