The katar or katara is a type of dagger to be pushed from India. The weapon is characterized by its horizontal H-shaped handle which makes the blade rest above the user's knuckles. It is the most famous and most characteristic of Indian daggers of which there are also Mongolian versions. Ceremonial katars were also used in worship. Katar (dagger) -
