Louis Peyrat (1911-1999) French painter born November 30, 1911 at La Gorceix in Saint Germain Les Belles, near Limoges (87). He apprenticed in carpentry, in parallel, he studied by correspondence at the universal school, received at his competition, he worked in an architectural firm in Limoges. For his leisure, he attended the School of Decorative Arts in Limoges, then from 1948 he exhibited at

the magadoux gallery in Limoges, then in Royan and in many other galleries. From 1958, he painted views of Paris, and particularly of Montmartre, which made his success. He entered the very famous Cercle Volney and Parisian galleries such as the Roussard gallery. His paintings were exhibited next to those of Degas, Derain, Domergue, Buffet, Braque, Picasso, Fajita, Utrillo, Laurencin, etc ... until 1969, year from which he will stop painting following complications caused by a traffic accident suffered a few years before ( 1963). His success will allow him to live comfortably until his death on March 13, 1999 at Martoulet in Saint-Germain-Les-Belles (87).
