Description: Historical episode - During the war of Genpei, from the story Ise Monogatari and the battle of Yashima in the strait between Honshu and Shikoku, the famous warrior prince, "Minamoto Yoshitsune" (Warrior prince High-ranking Samurai), from the Kamakura era with occult powers, riding his mount and descending an extremely steep slope, impossible for other warriors. His follower Hiroshige II, had the pseudonym Rissho, before the death of his stepfather, then Suzuki Hiroshige (II). From a collection of a former French aristocratic family, politician and poet. We can imagine that these works were made to order.
