Raymond Dierickx (1904-1978) "The engulfed village" feather 45 X 60 cm mounted under a neutral pH mat 60 X 80 cm.

Frankly dreamlike, this beautiful drawing shows us the ruins of a sunken village where the wreck of a ship lies, animated by different fish. It was for us a real discovery that this beautiful Belgian artist! Even found in leaves and dusty, these drawings, once prepared and framed, reveal all the talent of Dierickx, close to artists like Nicolas Eeckmann, Fritz Van den Berghe, Constant Permeke or other typically Flemish expressionists such as Anto Carte, representing Fêtes, processions, fairs in the great tradition of Flemish painters dating back to the 17th century with the Brughels, but treated with great modernity.
