Boulle-type clock, with console, 19th century, 101 cm On 4 folded legs with a turtle pattern, with a sumptuous wooden cabinet in the shape of a cello, glazed on three sides, covered with tortoiseshell marquetry and brass leaf cut with floral motifs and stylized floral geometric patterns. At the front, a glass door closed by an arch, in a palmette and rose motif frame; below, an openwork bronze overlay with a pomegranate on a background of acanthus leaves. Bronze with acanthus and rockery applied along the edge of the case. The top of the 4-pitched roof in the form of a figure of fame. The shield visible through the glass door - on a copper plate. It has a bronze shield with Roman numerals marking the hours, navy blue on applied white enamel badges and in the outer ring - Arabic numerals, black numerals

Ankr escapement mechanism, between two thick brass plates connected by pillars; on the outside plate, at the bottom, the inscription: "Colin A PARIS"; the Paris system for the striking hours and half-hours; steel bell bowl. The console is decorated, like the clock, with an axial and vegetal motif marquetry, with a crowned heart in the center of the facade. Along the edge below are acanthus, grid, and rockery overlays. At the bottom - acanthus.
