Cracked paint, but adhering well to its support.

Canvas resting on a panel, not mounted.

Frame in gilded wood and canvas.

Dimensions with frame: 56 X 46 cm.

Homero PANAGIOTOPULOS dedicated the second part of his life to full-time pictorial expression after practicing as a avant-garde experimental photographer and filmmaker in the 1960s in BUENOS AIRES.
