Description

Of exceptional Neapolitan manufacture, this elegant antique Smith cabinet was created with a mahogany feather door inlaid with maple In the upper part there is a pediment with a baroque inlay representing two animal figures. The hat has an arched sculpture also inlaid supported by two intricately carved pilasters with Corinthian capitals, the mirror is original from the period Below there are two drawers also inlaid with figures of warriors in battle George Smith: Owner from a large cabinetmaking workshop in London and active between 1804 and 1828, famous for having published in 1808 an engraving album titled "A Collection of Designs for Household Furniture", some scholars have put forward the hypothesis that Neapolitan furniture " Smith "is inspired by the designs of George Smith.
