Below: Onse Live Vrouw Tot Kevelaar (Our Lady of Kevelaar). Small fire decor in excellent condition, bright and fresh colors. Interestingly, the Virgin Mary is depicted with a bare chest. "The nursing virgin was the main symbol of God's love for mankind." "Maria Lactans" Kevelaer is a municipality in the district of Kleve, in North Rhine-Westphalia in Germany. It is the largest Catholic pilgrimage site in northwestern Europe.
