Description

Low sideboard in molded and carved oak. It opens with 2 drawers and 2 doors in the body of the cabinet and has, in the lower part, a drawer over the entire width. The whole rests on 2 ball feet at the front. Rich carved decoration. Iron mark on the rear upright "R M", supplier of Napoleon III: Ribaillier: cabinetmaker, sculptor. Mazaro, sculptor. Dimensions: width: 75 cm; height: 97 cm; depth: 50 cm. As is (some restorations to be expected). Napoleon III period. Mazaro, Jean-Paul, sculptor, born in Lons-le-Saunier (Jura), December 6, 1823. The activity of his house extended from around 1850 to 1890. Associated with RIBAILLIER, the company name was first in 1855 RIBAILLIER AÎNÉ ET MAZAROS P, then became MAZAROS-RIBAILLIER ET CIE from 1863.
