N $^{\circ}$ 1: Amboyna burl, floral motifs made with salt dough, placed under a convex glass plate. Strapping by a tortoiseshell ring. The slices of the object are left in varnished amboyna burl. N $^{\circ}$ 2/3/4: Opaline, cardboard box, painted floral motifs in good condition, sometimes having chips. Gilded brass strapping which extends on the edges of the boxes, bearing a stamped
