Gourd-shaped vase in glass paste with rounded body and flattened sides, flared neck of oval section, signed Gallé *, decorated in orange color cleared with acid flowers of bindweed hedges, Art Nouveau period late nineteenth - early twentieth centuries. This vase is in good condition. It is signed on the side. A note: some small scratches and dirt, especially on the collar and wear of time, see photos.

_____ * Émile Gallé (1846-1904) is a French industrialist, master glassmaker, cabinetmaker and ceramist. He was the founder and first president of the School of Nancy in 1901.
