18th century fireback, with the arms of 93x93, known as the Bon (1679-1729), son of Charles V, titular duke of Lorraine and Bar and of Eleanor of Austria, archduchess of Austria and queen dowager from Poland, he was married to Elisabeth Charlotte d'Orléans in 1698, the eldest daughter of Louis XIII; peaceful and generous sovereign who restored peace and prosperity to his subjects. 18th century plaque adorned with a plaque dated 1701 surrounded by five coats of arms on leather topped with a Duke's crown and a cross of Lorraine.
