"Dedied to Monsieur Blondel d'Azaincourt, lieutenant of infantry, knight of the royal and military order of St Louis"

Lower left .: printed by P. Aubert

In the middle: In Paris at Demarteau rue de la Pelterie at the bell near Palais with privilege of the Roy

Bottom right: by his very humble and very obedient servant Demarteau the groin.
