Study at the Academy of Brussels (1896-1906), at Charles Van Der Straeten (1843-1910) and Julien Dillens (1849-1904) 2nd Prix de Rome (1906) Travel across Europe, internships in Central Europe and Italy. Active for some time in London, as ornamentalist. Works under the direction of the sculpture Thomas Vinçotte (1850-1825), at the Royal Palace, helps the latter to complete his last great work: The Equestrian Statue of Leopold II, for the Place du Trône, in Brussels. , he is a member of the Apprentices Committee of the
