Magnificent Briard sideboard in oak from the 18th century. I am a native of this region of Brie that I have never left. Who hasn't heard of the Briard buffet at home? No one I think. Its cradle was Beton Bazoche where a certain cabinetmaker named Tresmé devoted his life to the manufacture of this piece of furniture. This support unit is often also called a square sideboard, in fact its height / width proportions are part of a square. The model presented here is interesting: its facade is nicely molded, the doors and crosspieces are finely carved. This piece of furniture has survived the years without accidents, so there have been few restorations. The interiors have been cleaned, disinfected and iced so that you can store your belongings without risk of odors or stains. Free delivery for mainland France. H 144 cm W 135
