## Description

Superb object, South Germany, (Augsburg or Nuremberg for export to Ottoman Empire), towards the end of the 18th century. The object is charming, and individually sized. Composed of 6 pieces of stamped brass, the jug rests on a pedestal, screwing to a cup stamped with floral decorations in relief, the scalloped border retains the body of a timpani with a spout, the interior of which has kept its original silver plating. A handle cast and chiseled brass joins the hinge of the repoussé lid, which presents at its top a branch of simulated coral, still silvered. Some flaws: wear, even disappearance of the original silver plating, small weaknesses in the foot, (barely visible cracks), beak a little chipped. Qualities: what a pretty model! What a nice assembly, old screws and beautiful nut. A
