The temptation is great for me to attribute it to Giovanni Fattori (1825-1908), whose initials not only correspond to the monogram, but who, moreover, before making his endless military scenes was the leader of the "macchiaioli", the "tachists" which would correspond a little to our impressionists transalpine version, but I do not know the expert and cannot therefore certify it, I will thus be satisfied to sell it as "concentrate of paint"!
