Description

Officer pistol type 1833 with damask barrel, XIX °. All metal parts engraved, walnut frame with half-length shaft, fluted stock with engraved metal cap. White polished nickel silver trim engraved with floral decoration. Oval trigger guard with rear part subdividing into two branches of which the longest form under guard, moreover the lower part of the trigger guard has a finger rest. The hood at the beginning of the barrel leaves the barrel uncovered has an opening for the passage of the rod present, wooden rod with brass tip nail type. Rear percussion lock, octagonal damascus barrel over its entire length bearing the "spangled ELG" hallmark (Liege from 1811 to 1893). Breech tail ending in a small rounded tongue fixed to the frame by a screw. Half moon handlebar without recess at the muzzle
