



Cabinet In Cabinet D Louis XIV Period



Description

Rare cabinet in two-part cabinet from the Louis XIV period, this piece of furniture is also called cabinet in "cabinet", appears in the second half of the 17th century. Combining the characteristics of the cabinet by its imposing framework usually made up of two superimposed bodies; it nevertheless preserves a precious aspect by the presence of small drawers and compartments but also by the materials used, here, the rosewood veneer or violet wood that we often find on Louis XIV commodes in Work veneer around 1680, the lower part opens with two doors, two drawers in the middle and the upper part opens with 10 drawers and a door in its center revealing drawers This "beautiful" and "rare" piece of furniture is presented in good used condition, however small accidents that can be taken back in our workshop
