As often I prefer the apparent unfinished, the
study to the final work - For Lecomte Du Noüy it
is flagrant, these large historical compositions
bore me while these many small studies of hands,
feet, or profiles remain extraordinary by their
tight framing, the chiaroscuro, the outrageous
lights - They were also on the return from his
many journeys in the East , cleverly listed for
monumental orders -

Descendant of a noble family from Piedmont
settled in France in the 14th century, Jean
Lecomte du Nouÿ was born in Paris in 1842 and
died there in 1923 -
he joined the studio of Jean Léon Gérôme who
made him his favorite pupil.

1872 he won the second Grand Prix de Rome -
1876 the Legion of Honor - Gold medalist at the
Universal Exhibition -

Exhibited all his life in the major Parisian salons.
Complete artist, Jean Lecomte du Nouÿ is a
painter and sculptor. From his many travels in the
East, he brought back sketchbooks and was

quickly considered as a painter of history above all orientalist. He was official painter of the Court of Romania. Travels to Egypt, and then Greece, Turkey and Romania. From then on he alternated religious subjects and orientalist paintings.
