It is decorated with Japanese and shiny, branches and flowers of Japanese cherry trees, finely engraved in reserve of orange amber colors on a yellow background with satiny orange shades. Signed "Gallé" in the decor.

Period around 1890 -1900.

Good condition, no cracks, no or very little wear, note a tiny chip (1 mm) on the lower base of the foot, without depth, very little visible (nothing serious see photos).
