



Fernand Elchinger Vase / Pitcher 1950



Description

This is one of the most impressive pieces by ceramist Fernand Elchinger, this large vase opens and flares like the petals of a flower or the wings of a bird, in a spirit of free form. This piece is an exceptional production from the mid-twentieth century. This vase is in good condition, a small enamel jump at the base very discreet (see photo). Signed, underneath, hollow, Elchinger France "Céramiques ELCHINGER", is a family business established in Soufflensheim in Alsace in 1834. Since that time, generations have followed one another and offer a production as varied as it is avant-garde. Léon Elchinger (1871-1942) will make an impression with artistic stoneware productions as well as magnificent Art Nouveau and then Art Deco pottery, with magnificent colors and brilliance.
