Elegant sloping coffered desk attributed to Migeon, in rosewood veneer, it opens on the front by a flap inlaid with patterns of crosses in the upper part, the latter forming a writing desk lined with leather, he discovers a set of small drawers and locker, the lower part of the desk opens with two drawers and two doors, it rests on four arched legs, bronze fittings and original locks, ht of the flap 67 It is a support unit; Work from the Louis XV period, attributed to Pierre II MIGEON, in fact this slope desk model is typical of the cabinetmaker's productions This "pretty" piece of furniture with elegant proportions is presented in good condition, with old small repairs, nice tones in the choices plating games
