The dancer, superbly dressed, carrying her tambourine high, shows the famous Giraffe Zarafa, the event queen of the years 1827 / and 28, offered to French King Charles X by Méhémet-Ali ... A true girafomania touched more or less all the arts, from painting to engraving, letters in feminine fashion, earthenware, and therefore also my table bell!
