Description

Stunning fountain basin or table centerpiece in Moustiers earthenware/ceramic from middle of 18th century, with mythological decoration.

The coin bears the interlaced OL antimony marks on the reverse for the Olérys and Laugier workshop and the initial P for the famous decorator Jean-François Pelloquin. This brand association also attests that the piece was manufactured before 1748, the date of departure of Pelloquin from this manufacture, just after Joseph Oléry's death. This large size ceramic is scalloped in shape, rests on 4 imposing protruding feet in the shape of 4 lying lions, and ends with 2 Indians or grotesques' heads.

The central mythological decoration features

ancient deity Orpheus charming animals, seated on a rock, wearing a breastplate and leaning on a lyre, surrounded by 2 felines in a forest landscape. The scene is framed by a large polychrome floral frieze. The "grand feu" polychromy used here allows the use of blue (cobalt oxide) green (copper oxide) ocher (antimony oxide) and manganese (oxide of the same name).

The basin outline is decorated with rich floral garlands with same colors.
