Léon Broquet (1869-1935) Oil on canvas representing the old bridge at Sospel in the Alpes Maritimes (presumed location).

We can make out the alpine mountains in the background. Beautiful colors. The architectural parts such as the fortified bridge and the buildings are executed with a knife giving relief to the whole.

Original frame gilded with leaf (wear).

A pupil of Claude Monet, Antoine Guillemet and Alexandre Nozal, Espérance Léon Cléophas Broquet, aka Léon Broquet mainly produces oils on canvas, but also etchings, watercolors and murals. Renowned as an army painter during the
