stripped of a sentence like other copies in public
libraries (perhaps a vintage censorship). Printer's
mark: a boat on the Seine, emblem of the city of
Paris. The first book deals with the founding of
the city of Paris. The second book deals with the
founding of the University of Paris. The third
book deals with the founding of churches, chapels
and hospitals in the city of Paris as well as the
institution of provosts, aldermen and consuls. The
fourth book deals with the founding of the
monasteries of the diocese of Paris. A capital
book for lovers of the history of Paris.
