Writer, poet, politician, socialist, knight of the Legion of Honour, was introduced to Freemasonry in 1908 at the "Victor Hugo" lodge of the Godf, he also attended the lodge "la Jérusalem Ecosaise No. 99" of the Gldf. He was received at the Chapter of the "Clemente Amitié" in 1912 and was very active in the Conseil de l'Ordre, the Grand College des Rites and the Supreme Conseil pour la France.
