Second Empire terminal clock in onyx and gilded bronze. In the center of the base is inscribed a dial with Roman numeral signed "L. Charvet Ainé, Horloger de la ville de Lyon", adorned with garlands of laurel twists, ribbon knots and muzzles of lions with drooping rings, topped with an imperial eagle. Rests on claw feet. The movement has been revised and is in perfect working order. It strikes the hours and a half. Nineteenth century.
