Belgian painter, engraver and master glassmaker,

René Mels studied at the academies of Leuven

and Brussels (1930-1933) then at the National

School of Architecture and Visual Arts in La

Cambre (1937-1938). He began as a figurative

painter in the 1930s and began in 1940 in painting
aimed at synthesizing figuration and abstraction.

Member of the Jeune Peinture Belge group, he

participated in the 1947 exhibition at the Palais

des Beaux-Arts in Brussels. Works at the Royal
