## CEREMONIAL SHORT SWORD

Konda culture, Democratic Republic of Congo First half of the 20th century

Height: 42 cm; Width: 20,5 cm

(Old crack in the wood)

The Konda culture can be identified by the particular cut of the blade at the proximal part: a triangle whose apex is included in the handle gives rise to an adjoining disc. The blade then tapers to a thin rectangular band and divides into two asymmetrical calligraphic excrescences that signify "Allah".

The wood is cylindrical, covered with a coiled iron ligature.
