Description

CEREMONIAL SHORT SWORD

Konda culture, Democratic Republic of Congo First half of the 20th century Iron and wood Height : 42 cm ; Width : 20,5 cm (Old crack in the wood)

The Konda culture can be identified by the particular cut of the blade at the proximal part: a triangle whose apex is included in the handle gives rise to an adjoining disc. The blade then tapers to a thin rectangular band and divides into two asymmetrical calligraphic excressences that signify "Allah".

The wood is cylindrical, covered with a coiled iron ligature.

On a bronze base.
