

The Justinian code formed the basis of Roman law. Justinian was the first Byzantine emperor depicted with a cross. In the 5th century, he made uniform Roman law and the Church of Hagia Sophia was built during his reign. He is considered as a saint by the Orthodox Christians. The Novellas Constitutiones were administrative reforms which aimed to install and maintain the developing Byzantine Empire since it had just acquired a good number of
